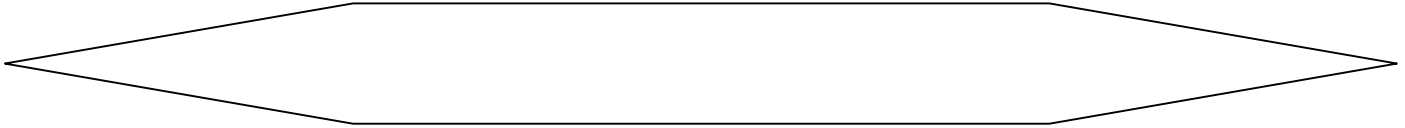

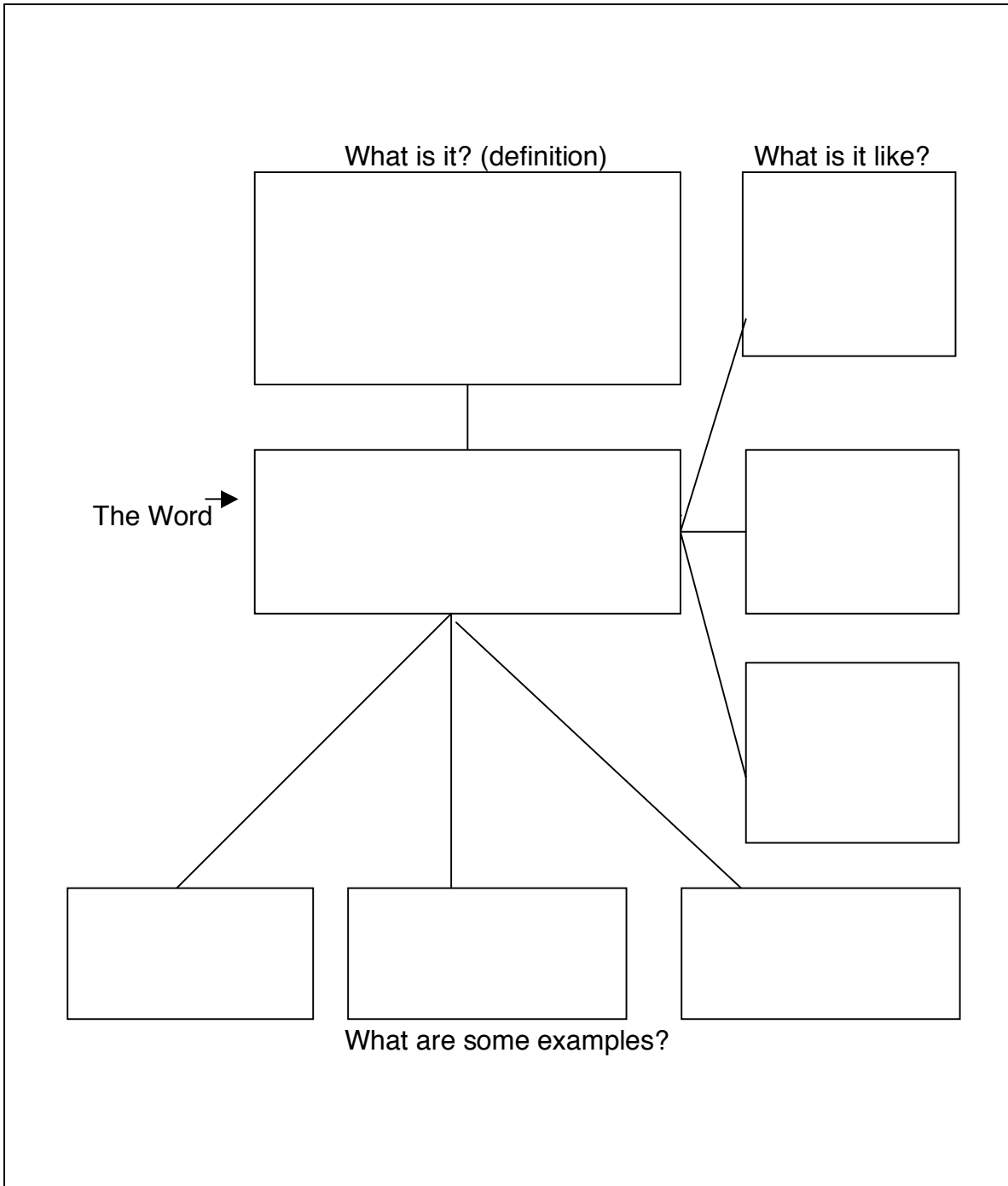
# Four-Square Vocabulary
